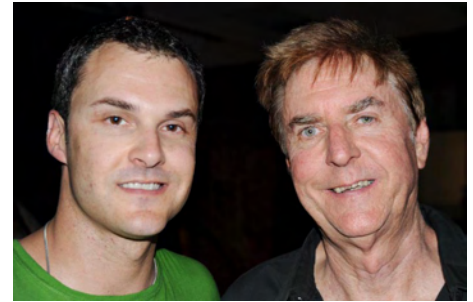

All listings were correct as supplied at the time of publication but may be subject to later alterations. Please always check with the artists and or venues to confirm the gigs. See page 1 for ACMC gigs!

The more comprehensive Gig guide is included in this issue as there is unlikely to be another SACCM Prelude printed in the foreseeable future. To save space, some of the gigs outside of the metro area have not been included. There may well be more in January that are unknown to me!

EVONNE'S APPLE CAKE

Ingredients: 2 cups Self Raising Flour ¾ cup Sugar
 2 tablespoons Butter 1 Egg
 ½ cup Milk Pinch of Salt

Method: Cream butter and sugar, add egg and sifted flour and then milk - I add a little extra flour to make a stiffer dough.

Spread drained stewed apple on half, cover with other half and cook at 180 degrees C for about 40 minutes. Ice with white icing and sprinkle with cinnamon. I use canned pie apple instead of stewing apple.

HUMMINGBIRD CAKE

INGREDIENTS:-

1 cup sugar	1 cup oil (Canola)
3 eggs	1½ cups plain flour
1½ teaspoon bi-carb soda	1½ teaspoon baking powder
1½ teaspoon cinnamon	1½ cups grated carrot
¾ cup well drained crushed pineapple	½ cup walnuts (chopped)
1 teaspoon vanilla	

METHOD:

1. Beat sugar and oil well together.
2. Add eggs one at a time and continue beating.
3. Add sifted flour and other dry ingredients.
4. Continue beating for a few minutes.
5. Fold in carrot, pineapple, chopped walnuts and vanilla.
6. Bake at 300° F (150 C) for about forty minutes.
7. Take out when cake springs back to touch.

ICING:-

Tablespoon margarine – melted. Add 2 tablespoon milk and 1 teaspoon vanilla. Add icing sugar to required consistency. Apply to cake then sprinkle with walnuts. *(thanks to Raelz for typing these up and sending them to me)*
