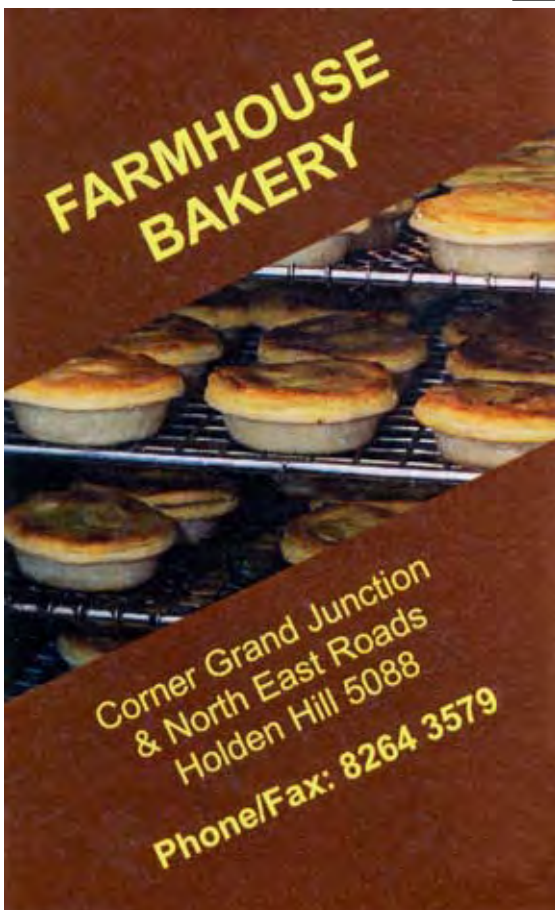
Port River Twilight Dinner Dance Cruise on Dolphin Explorer

July Show Guest Artist:- Billy Dee

Billy Dee arrived in Adelaide in 1976 under the name Bill Dagnall from Liverpool, England. I loved everything about it except for the lack of live music in the southern area where I lived. As a result of my advertising in the then Southern Times and meeting in my front lounge, the first Southern Districts Country/Folk club was formed.

I have moved on with other commitments in the entertainment field, and have performed both here and overseas in bands, duos and solo work.

Regular shows include:- casino, concerts, festivals (Aldinga, Francis, Kapunda), clubs (British Working Mans, RSLs, Football & Irish Assoc.), Hotels (both city and country).

I am currently heading a country/folk band called "Rare Old Times" and also as a duo with my partner Cindee as the "Mellow Dees".

SA Artist Trans-Tasman Entertainer of the Year 3 years in a row!

Melody Feder made it three years in a row for a South Australia artist in the competition on Wednesday evening May 18 2011 by winning the Norfolk Island Country Music Festival Trans-Tasman Entertainer of the year. She competed against seven others who had all won awards where they came from. There were three from Australia and five from New Zealand. In 2010 Melody had won the South Australian Champion of Champions and also the Victorian equivalent. In January in Tamworth she came home with the Aristocrat Entertainer of the year title and the Country Music Association of Australia (CMAA) songwriters award and the overall highest points award.

Melody will be off to the CMAA Academy of Country Music from June 25th to July 10th this year.

Last year our Angela Easson won in Norfolk Island and the previous year our Kristal Collins!

Melody will be at our club in August, so make sure you don't miss her!

As well as the completion there was lots of country music on the New Zealand and Australian Showcase evenings as well as a concert and hoedown on Friday. When not at music events there are many tours to choose from or one can just drive around and admire the wonderful scenery! I even managed to have a couple of swims this trip!

Two young artists also performed, Margie-May Hockey from NSW and Knona Naoupu Va'aga, both were very good. Featured artists included Gina Keating, Roger Tibbs and Aly Cook from New Zealand. Roger was especially good! From Australia was Mitchell Shadlow plus the lovely

I was raised on a diet of Hank Williams, Jim Reeves etc and loved all those country legends. And then the Beatles and the Eagles hit me and I guess country rock got into me. But I don't want to be cured!

I enjoy the different shades and sounds of music, but I know that country is in my blood.

Hope we can catch up sometime.

Len Wakefield Memorial Fund

Subject to certain conditions, the purpose of the fund is to assist younger talent with proven ability: a) in entering talent quests throughout Sth Aust, Mildura and Tamworth, b) by payment or part payment of professional tuition, and c) towards the cost of a musical instrument. The fund is administered by the APMC committee with

expenditure limited to the interest from capital invested, with all payments made to the appropriate body and NOT to the awardee. Annually an awardee is chosen at an event deemed suitable by the Full Committee by a judging panel consisting of three suitably qualified APMC committee members. Contributions to the fund, which may be made to the club treasurer at any time will be acknowledged in the club newsletter.
