SURVEY INFORMATION.

Dear Members,

Recently survey forms were sent to all current members and to past members who had not renewed their membership for three (3) years.

In all, 158 surveys were received from current members and 36 from past members.

The information received from past members revealed that many had moved, had sickness, had no transport etc. Very few had a problem with the Club. Their comments were noted with interest and combined with the comments from current members.

Of the current members, approximately 25% of those that returned the surveys were dissatisfied with the venue, the Greyhound Park Function Centre, albeit the venue itself, the access entry, the dance floor condition, stage position, split level, drink pricing etc. A greater percentage considered that there was an atmosphere problem which may have been due to a split audience and split level.

The surveys also revealed that they were extremely happy with our catering, show times, Club days, fees, committee, band selections, band performances, walkups, raffles and daily programming. As such, there will be no change to these latter issues.

As a result of the survey information and from member and past members' comments the Sub-Committee made the following recommendations to the Club Committee, whom accepted such recommendations;

1. That an alternate venue be sought that will satisfy all members and members' guests needs.
2. That a short introduction be given by the Entertainment Officer prior to the show commencing. The main announcements to be made in band breaks.
3. That a free door entry be given to any member who introduces a new member to the Club.
4. That the 'future directions' recommendations of the Club be reconsidered.
5. That the ACMC write to all kindred clubs seeking their views to increasing 'reciprocal membership' by \$1 over and above member door fees.

In relation to recommendation (1), we have been very fortunate to now have use of the **Slovenian Club, 11 LaSalle St. Dudley Park**, (off Pym St.) on a long term basis. A location diagram is shown below.

Our first show there will be on Sunday 7th February '99. We are sure that all members will be happy and hopefully the purpose of the survey will be achieved in that membership and attendances will increase.

Committee are very happy too inasmuch as there is very little setting up the hall, although we are required to clean after the show.

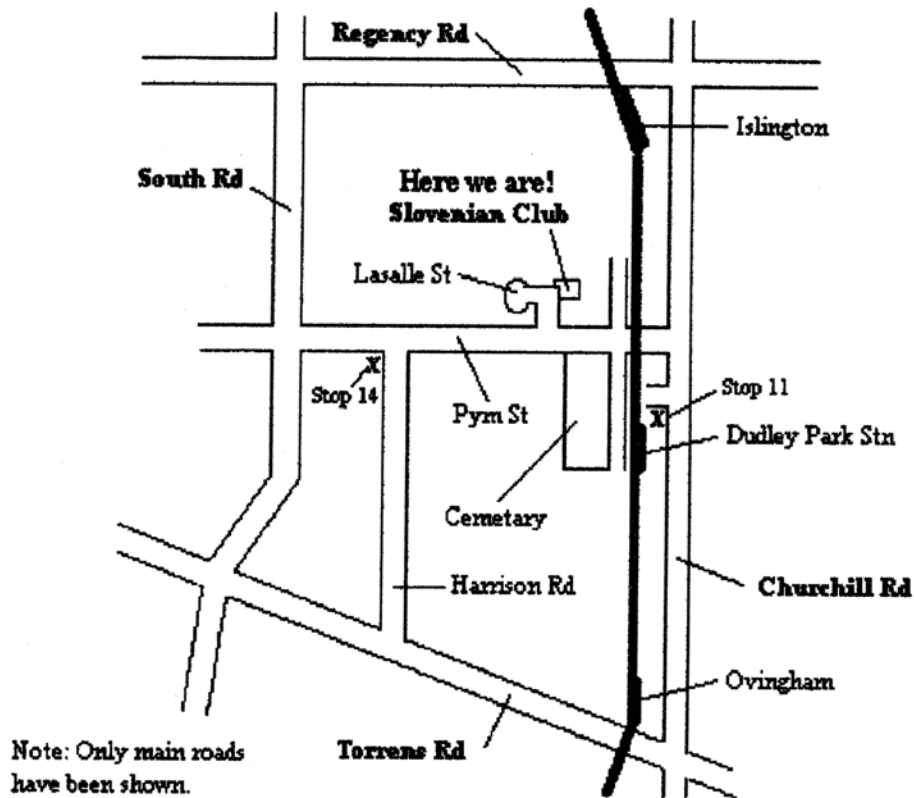
There is bus (237 route to Pym St.) and train transport to Dudley Park for those who use public transport. These members can contact me for timetable information.

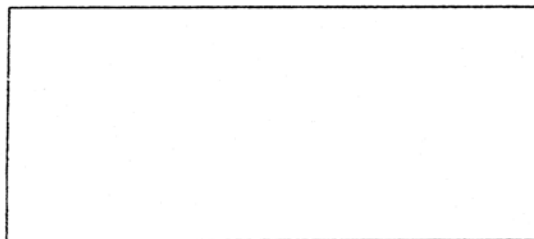
